Under the aegis of the Crisil CSR Policy, **Crisil Re**, Crisil's environment conservation programme focuses on the urban afforestation by planting native trees in the vicinity of Crisil offices. Apart from plantations, Crisil Re interventions also include water harvesting and conservation structures in new/existing plantation sites to complement the green cover to enable long-term sustenance.
